The Miss Texas Volunteer Organization's Heart of Texas Princess Program is for young ladies age six (6) to twelve (12) years old. The Miss Texas Volunteer America Pageant is a nationwide, service-oriented scholarship program based in Tennessee that seeks to empower young women across the country through educational scholarships and extraordinary opportunities. There are five principles in the Miss Volunteer America Organization: S.E.R.V.E

Princesses may be appointed by a Local Titleholder/Organization or may register independently and be assigned to a Local Titleholder. The Miss Texas Volunteer and Miss Texas Teen Volunteer Local Titleholders will serve as mentors to the Heart of Texas Princesses. All Heart of Texas Princesses will participate in some aspect of the Miss Texas Volunteer or Miss Texas Teen Volunteer Pageant state production numbers.

Upon approval, you will be notified by a Miss Texas Volunteer Pageant Official and a schedule and list of all requirements will be supplied by June 1st. You can find more information and complete registration on the website. www.MissTexasVolunteer.org

General Information

The deadline for submitting your application and fees is May 1st

Age Eligibility:

The Heart of Texas Princess age eligibility requirement is based on a calendar year, not a pageant cycle. The Princess must be at least six (6) on the June 1st and not older than twelve (12) on December 31st.

Miss Texas Volunteer Pageant Details:

Housing:

All Heart of Texas Princesses, their families, and friends are responsible for their own housing, transportation, and meals during pageant week. Information regarding the Pageant Headquarters Hotel with Miss Texas Volunteer Pageant rates will be on the Miss Texas Volunteer website.

Tickets:

Heart of Texas Princesses and one chaperone will each receive one season ticket to the state pageant. You will receive emails regarding any prepurchased ticketed events during the week. Your Local Titleholder is also a great source of information.

Attendance:

Rehearsals, preliminaries, and final pageant attendance is mandatory. The first rehearsal is most crucial, so Princesses must be in attendance from the first day to the last.

Please Note: NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER JUNE 1ST FOR ANY REASON.

Princess Dress Requirements

Heart of Texas Princesses should be well-maintained and presentable at all times.

- **Badge –** Must be worn at all times, unless performing on the main stage.
- **Rehearsal Clothes –** Warm-ups, t-shirt, capris/jeans, and tennis shoes. Black bottoms, White tops, White shoes, Hair pulled back and secured.
- Production Number Attire Details announced by June 1.
- White Party/Pageant Dress The dress length should fall between the knee and ankle. The dress must NOT touch the floor.
- White or Clear Shoes <u>NO SANDALS</u>. Shoes should be age appropriate and for safety, should be secure when running, dancing and climbing.
- Heart of Texas Princess Sash Please do not add "bling" or embellish.
- Official Heart of Texas Princess Crown

Please note: The producer may require additional costumes. If required, details will be provided no later than June 1st.



General Rules and Precepts of Conduct

The Precepts of Conduct for Princesses are the foundation upon which the image and reputation of the Heart of Texas Princess Program has been built and will continue to be the basis for its operation.

- 1. A Heart of Texas Princess will always conduct themselves with dignity, grace and good manners of young ladies who exemplify the integrity of American youth.
- 2. A Princess must observe all rules and regulations from the time of her arrival until her departure. She must register by the official designated time and remain through checkout as determined by Pageant Staff. Any Princess whose conduct is deemed unbecoming by the Heart of Texas Princess Pageant Committee will be asked to withdraw from the Program.
- 3. A Princess will not participate in any interview, picture, and/or press contact or any type of publicity unless a member of the Heart of Texas Princess Committee is present or Heart of Texas Director has approved said media.
- 4. From the time a Princess arrives until the pageant is completed, she is under the jurisdiction of The Miss Texas Volunteer Pageant and must abide by its Rules and Regulations.
- 5. All problems or complaints should be reported immediately to the Heart of Texas Princess Program Director.
- 6. Regardless of how small or large a complaint, please report it. A PROBLEM CANNOT BE SOLVED IF NO ONE KNOWS ABOUT IT.
- 7. All Princesses must be checked in and out with their Heart of Texas Princess Group Committee Leader at all official Princess events during pageant week which includes production rehearsals, preliminary competitions, and the final competition night.
- 8. All Princesses are ALWAYS required to wear their name badge.
- 9. No one is permitted backstage at any time, except Security, Stage Personnel and Pageant Officials. No one may enter the Princess area at any time, except authorized personnel.
- 10. Transportation, Housing and Meals: You must provide your own transportation while participating in the Miss or Teen Volunteer Pageant. All Princesses, their families and friends are responsible for their housing and meals during pageant week.

11. Make sure your Princess knows which Organization she is representing.
